The schools in this school district will develop a well-rounded and age-appropriate activities program that provides opportunities for students to participate in activities which may include, but are not limited to, journalism and yearbook, music, speech and drama, and interscholastic athletics. To provide a variety of activities for students, the school district will periodically assess the types of activities offered, the scheduling of facilities and activities, and the expenditure of funds.

Recognizing the importance of a well-rounded activities program to the academic, social, and physical development of students, and recognizing the limited funding available for such activities, this school district requires that all student participants, regardless of the activity, pay a nominal fee. These fees are for the operation of the activity only.

The building principal will work on an individual basis with student(s) unable to respond to a requested fee for financial reasons.

At times coaches have the opportunity to require additional fees for extra activities relating to that sport or organization with the approval of the building administrator. Fees will be held in a dedicated fund to offset costs of operating the student activities program. Students who are unable to pay the fee may receive a full or partial waiver as determined by the superintendent or designee on a case-by-case basis.

Extracurricular Student Activities

Extracurricular Activities Fee

Each school activity has a participation fee, which should be paid by the first practice unless other arrangements have been made with the building principal. These fees are used for tape, consumable supplies, travel and uniforms. No fees are returned if the student quits a team or becomes academically ineligible.

High School fees are set as follows:

1. Fees for cheerleading, dance, football, basketball, volleyball, wrestling, and soccer are \$50.00 for each activity.
2. Fee for track, golf, and cross-country are \$30.00.
3. The school reserves the right to charge a \$5.00 late fee for each and every week a uniform is late beyond the first five days as noted above. There are no exceptions to this rule unless approved by the principal.

Middle School fees are set as follows:

1. Fees for athletic teams are \$50.00.

Cheerleading fees are \$10.00.
