

GENERAL

The district will operate school breakfast, lunch and after school snacks for the benefit of the regularly enrolled students of the district and authorized adults. The programs will be operated in compliance with all appropriate United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) regulations concerning the operation of school food programs.

The programs will be financed through allowable regular or special funds in this district, including the Commodity Support Program. Per the National School Lunch Act and Idaho Code 33-1015, which require each district that participates in the National School Lunch program to pay employer retirement and social security cost for the school lunch program from the state general account appropriation for public school support. The programs will be operated so that regular operating costs come from the state and federal programs as well as money collected from the sale of meals to students and adults. The price of the sale of meals to students and adults will be established annually at the July school board meeting.

When necessary, the board may expend capital or operating funds for support of the programs, subject to the regular budgetary procedures of the district.

SPECIFIC

Use of facilities and/or equipment, to include supplies, is to be coordinated through the District Food Service Supervisor no later than ten (10) school days prior to the scheduled need of the teacher. Teacher sponsored learning activities may not conflict with normal food service operations. All cost for supplies in support of learning activity may be charged to the individual school's budget.

Supervision of student eating area is the responsibility of the building principals, who will assign either certified or classified employees or a combination of both to lunchroom duty as part of the normal duty roster. Principals must comply with the "Duty Free Lunch" provision of the negotiated agreement.

Discipline and general rules of behavior will be set and enforced by the building principals with the assistance of the district food service staff.
