

**ABERDEEN SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 58**  
**Special School Board Executive Session**  
**January 29, 2013**

The Board of Trustees of School District No. 58, Bingham County, Idaho met in a special executive session beginning at 10:34 a.m. on Tuesday, January 29, 2013 at the Aberdeen School District Office, 318 W. Washington, Aberdeen, Idaho.

**CALL TO ORDER AND ESTABLISHMENT OF A QUORUM**

Chairman Toevs opened the meeting at 10:34 a.m. Present were Ritchey Toevs, Elaine Blik, and Andrea Myler. Absent were Trustees Marc Foster and Ken Woods.

A motion was made at 10:34 a.m. by Chairman Toevs to go into Executive Session. The motion was seconded by Trustee Blik. The roll call was as follows: Chairman Toevs – Yes; Trustee Blik – Yes; Trustee Myler – Yes; Trustee Foster – Absent; and Trustee Woods – Absent.

**PURPOSE OF MEETING AS ADVERTISED AND BUSINESS CONDUCTED**

The meeting was announced to hold a special executive session to conduct expulsion hearings for Student “A” regarding unacceptable student behavior and Student “B” regarding a weapons violation.

A motion was made at 12:22 p.m. by Trustee Blik and seconded by Trustee Myler to recess from Executive Session into open meeting. The motion passed.

A motion was made by Trustee Myler and seconded by Trustee Blik to expel Student A for one (1) year, able to re-enroll with stipulations the second semester next year (FY2013-2014) (Notification of expulsion to be sent by certified mail). The motion passed.

A motion was made by Trustee Myler and seconded by Trustee Blik to suspend Student B for eight (8) days to come back with stipulations (Notification of suspension to be sent by certified mail). The motion passed.

With no further business to conduct, the meeting adjourned at 12:23 p.m.
