

The five (5) trustee zones for Aberdeen School District will be as follows:

TRUSTEE ZONE 1

BEGINNING at the Northwest corner of the Aberdeen School District Boundary being at the Northwest Corner of Section 19, Township 3 South, Range 30 East, thence along said School District Boundary the following six courses:
East along the Sections to 1700 West Road, thence
South on said 1700 West Road to 700 South Road (Thurston Road), thence
East on said 700 South Road (Thurston Road) to 1600 West Road, thence
South on said 1600 West Road to the Snake River, thence
Southwesterly along the Snake River to the Bingham-Bannock county line, thence
Southwesterly along said county line being along the thread of the Snake River within American Falls Reservoir to a point being near the NE Corner of the SE¼, SW ¼ of Section 31, T.5S., R.32 E. B.M., thence leaving said county line and said School District Boundary
Northwest approximately 3,600 feet to the Western shoreline of said American Falls reservoir, thence
Northeasterly along said Western shoreline to an unnamed creek being generally parallel with and approximately 0.5 miles south of 1200 South Road, thence
West on said unnamed creek to 2300 West Road, thence
North on 2300 West Road to 1100 South Road, thence
West on 1100 South Road to 2600 West Road, thence
South on 2600 West Road to said 1200 South Road, thence
West on said 1200 South Road to Powerline Road, thence
South on Powerline Road to 1500 South Road (Vanderford Road), thence
West on 1500 South Road (Vanderford Road) to 3100 West Road, thence
South on 3100 West Road to 1600 South Road, thence
West on 1600 South Road to 3300 West Road (Driscoll Road) thence
North on 3300 West Road (Driscoll Road) to said 1500 South Road (Vanderford Road), thence
West on 1500 South Road (Vanderford Road) to 3600 West Road (County Line Road) and the Bingham-Power County Line and being the West line of said School District Boundary, thence
North on said West line to the **POINT OF BEIGINNING**.

TRUSTEE ZONE 2

BEGINNING at a point on the West line of the Aberdeen School District Boundary on being the intersection of 1500 South Road to 3600 West Road (County Line Road) on the Bingham-Power County Line, thence continuing on said West line
South along said 3600 West Road (County Line Road) to the Southwest corner of said School District at 2300 South Road (County Line Road), thence along the South line of said School District Boundary,
East along said 2300 South Road to 3000 West Road (Moser Road), thence leaving said South line of said School District Boundary

North along said 3000 West Road (Moser Road) to 1700 South Road (Boat Dock Road), thence
 East on said 1700 South Road (Boat Dock Road) to 2750 West Road (Slough Road), thence
 South on said 2750 West Road (Slough Road) to Ada Avenue, thence
 East on Ada Avenue to Main Street (State Highway 39), thence
 South on said Main Street (State Highway 39) to Central Avenue, thence
 East on Central Avenue to the alley between 4th Street East and 5th Street East, thence
 South on said alley to Washington Avenue, thence
 East on said Washington Avenue to 7th Street East (2700 West Road), thence
 North on said 7th Street East (2700 West Road) to 1700 South Road (Boat Dock Road), thence
 East and Southeast on said 1700 South Road (Boat Dock Road) to the Western shoreline of the Big Hole Arm of American Falls Reservoir thence
 Southeasterly on said shoreline to a point at the mouth of said Big Hole arm thence
 Northeast approximately 950 feet across said mouth to the Western shoreline of said reservoir, thence
 Northeasterly along said Western shoreline to an unnamed creek being generally parallel with and approximately 0.5 miles south of 1200 South Road, thence
 West on said unnamed creek to 2300 West Road, thence
 North on 2300 West Road to 1100 South Road, thence
 West on 1100 South Road to 2600 West Road, thence
 South on 2600 West Road to said 1200 South Road, thence
 West on said 1200 South Road to Powerline Road, thence
 South on Powerline Road to 1500 South Road (Vanderford Road), thence
 West on 1500 South Road (Vanderford Road) to 3100 West Road, thence
 South on 3100 West Road to 1600 South Road, thence
 West on 1600 South Road to 3300 West Road (Driscoll Road) thence
 North on 3300 West Road (Driscoll Road) to said 1500 South Road (Vanderford Road), thence
 West on 1500 South Road to 3600 West Road (County Line Road) and the Bingham-Power County Line and being the West line of said School District Boundary, thence
 North on said West line to the **POINT OF BEIGINNING**.

TRUSTEE ZONE 3

BEGINNING at the intersection of 2800 West Road (Powerline Road) and 1700 South (Boat Dock Road), thence
 East on said 1700 South Road (Boat Dock Road) to 2750 West Road (Slough Road), thence
 South on said 2750 West Road (Slough Road) to Ada Avenue, thence
 East on Ada Avenue to Main Street (State Highway 39), thence
 South on said Main Street (State Highway 39) to Central Avenue, thence
 West on Central Avenue to said 2800 West (Powerline Road), thence
 North on said 2800 West (Powerline Road) to said 1700 South (Boat Dock Road) and the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.

TRUSTEE ZONE 4

BEGINNING at the intersection of 2300 South Road (County Line Road) and 3000 West Road (Moser Road) being on the Aberdeen School District south boundary line, thence
North along said 3000 West Road (Moser Road) to 1700 South Road (Boat Dock Road), thence
East on said 1700 South Road (Boat Dock Road) to 2800 West Road (Powerline Road), thence
South on said 2800 West Road (Powerline Road) to Central Avenue, thence
East on said Central Avenue to the alley between 2nd Street West and 3rd Street West, thence
South on said alley to Custer Avenue, thence
East on said Custer Avenue to said 2nd Street West, thence
South on said 2nd Street West to State Highway 39, thence
Southwest along said State Highway 39 to 1800 South Road (Beach Road), thence
East on said 1800 South Road (Beach Road) to the Aberdeen City Limits line, thence
North along said city limits line to the intersection of 1700 South Road and 2700 West Road, thence leaving said city limits line,
East and Southeast on said 1700 South Road (Boat Dock Road) to the Western shoreline of the Big Hole Arm of American Falls Reservoir thence
Southeasterly on said shoreline to a point at the mouth of said Big Hole arm thence
Northeast approximately 800 feet across said mouth to a point in American Falls Reservoir, thence
Southeast approximately 3,600 feet to the thread of the Snake River within American Falls Reservoir being near the NE Corner of the SE¹/₄, SW ¹/₄ of Section 31, T.5S., R.32 E. B.M. and being on the Aberdeen School District boundary, thence continuing along said school district boundary
Southwesterly along said thread of the Snake River within American Falls Reservoir to the South boundary of said school district also being the Bingham-Power County line, thence
West on said South boundary and said county line to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.

TRUSTEE ZONE 5

BEGINNING at the intersection of Main Street (State Highway 39) and Central Street, thence
East on said Central Street to the alley between 4th Street East and 5th Street East, thence
South on said alley to Washington Avenue, thence
East on said Washington Avenue to 7th Street East, thence
North on said 7th Street East to Central Street (1750 South), thence
East on Central Street (1750 South) to a point where the Aberdeen City Limits departs said Central Street (1750 South) to the Southeast, thence
Following said City limits Southeast, thence Southwest, thence West, thence South to the intersection with 1800 South Road , thence
West on said 1800 South Road (becoming Beach Road) to its intersection with State Highway 39, thence

Northeast on said State Highway 90 to the intersection with 2nd Street West, thence North on said 2nd Street West to its intersection with Custer Avenue, thence West on said Custer Avenue to the alley between 2nd Street West and 3rd Street West, thence North on said alley to its intersection with said Central Avenue, thence East on said Central Avenue to its intersection with Main Street (State Highway 39) and the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.

REDEFINING TRUSTEE ZONES

The boundaries of the trustee zones in this district are to be defined and drawn so that, as reasonably as may be, each such zone shall have approximately the same population. Trustee zones in this district will be determined to have approximately the same population when the populations of each trustee zone do not vary by more than ten percent (10%).

A proposal to redefine and change trustee zones of this district may be initiated by the board of trustees or by petition signed by not less than fifty (50) school electors residing in the district. If initiated by the board of trustees, such proposal will be initiated at the first meeting following the report of the decennial census. A petition to redefine and change trustee zones may be submitted to the board of trustees at any time. Within one hundred twenty (120) days following the report of the decennial census or the receipt of a petition to redefine and change the trustee zones, the board will prepare a proposal for a change which will equalize the population in each trustee zone and submit the proposal to the State Board of Education. The proposal will include a legal description of each trustee zone as the same would appear pursuant to the proposal, a map of the district showing how each trustee zone would appear, and the approximate population each trustee zone would have, should the proposal become effective. Any proposal to redefine the boundaries of the several trustee zones shall include the determination, where appropriate, the number of trustee zones in each district, and the date of expiration of the term of office for each trustee.

The superintendent or designee will be authorized to review the decennial census, or any proposal to change trustee zone boundaries, and determine whether there has been a shift in population which causes the current trustee zones to not contain approximately the same populations. If it is determined that the population has changed so that the trustee zones are not of approximately the same population, the board will appoint a committee, composed of interested parties, to review the matter. The committee will propose to the board modifications to the trustee zone boundaries which are intended to equalize the population in the various trustee zones.

The State Board of Education will approve or disapprove of the proposal within sixty (60) days and give notice of its decision to the board of trustees in writing. If approved, the trustee zones will change pursuant to the proposal and the district must file a copy of the legal description of each redefined trustee zone and a map of the district showing how each trustee zone will appear with the county clerk. If disapproved, the board must submit a revised proposal to the State

Board of Education within forty-five (45) days. Trustee zones may be redefined and changed not more than once every five (5) years.

IMPLEMENTATION OF PROPOSAL TO REDEFINE TRUSTEE ZONES

At the next regular meeting of the board following the approval of the proposal, the board will appoint from its membership a trustee for each new trustee zone to serve as trustee until that incumbent trustee’s term expires. If the current board membership includes two (2) incumbent trustees from the same new trustee zone, the board will select the incumbent trustee with the most seniority as the trustee to serve the remainder of his or her term. If both incumbent trustees have equal seniority, the board will choose one (1) of the trustees by the drawing of lots. If there is a trustee vacancy in any trustee zone, the board will appoint an individual residing in the trustee zone to serve as trustee until the next annual meeting. At the next trustee election, a trustee shall be elected to serve during the term specified in the election for the zone. The elected trustee shall assume office at the annual meeting of the board of trustees next following the election.
